# Why Aches and Pains?

As humans, we want to avoid pain. Unfortunately, since the big drama in the Garden of Eden (Genesis 3), pain has been our companion during our time on Earth.

## **Avoiding Pain**

Although with care, you can avoid many things that cause pain, you can't entirely avoid pain. One reason is that you can't control other people or circumstances. Others may not be careful (text while driving as they crash into you, leave things out that might cause you to trip). Nature can be an issue (icy sidewalks causing you to fall, tree branches falling on your head, bugs biting you).

### Danger of No Pain

Pain can help us learn from our mistakes. If you put your hand on a hot stove burner, you experience pain. You learn that it's best to be careful around stove burners in the future. If you felt no pain, it would take you longer to realize what was causing the damage to your hand.
