What good is a fruit tree that does not bear fruit?

When you are a true Christ-follower, He expects you to bear fruit. **John 15:16**

What does it take for you to bear fruit?

Trees don't "try" to bear fruit. Fruit is the result of staying rooted, taking in water and nutrients, and staying in the light.

- How is a tree staying rooted in the ground like you staying focused on God? Psa 1:2-3, Col 2:6-7
- How is a tree taking in water and nutrients like you continuing to take in God's Word? Psa 119:72
- How is a tree reaching toward the light like you praising God?
 Psa 63:3-4

- Pausing to praise God, Heb 13:15
- Giving to God, **Php 4:16-17**
