Parable of the Vineyard

Jesus often told parables to make His points. Read Mark 12:1-12.

- In what way is God like the owner in the parable?
- If God is the owner, the vineyard is His Kingdom. How is the nation of Israel like the vinedressers (husbandmen)?
- How are the servants in the parable like the prophets who gave warnings to Israel? What choice did the vinedressers make about the servants?
- If God is the owner in the parable, Jesus is the Son. What choices did the vinedressers make about the Son?
 Psa 118:22-23, Mark 11:27-31,
- The others in the parable are like Christ-followers. If you are a Christ-follower how are you like the others?
 Acts 28:28, Gal 3:28, Gal 4:7

Consider Your Choices

Eternal Choice	Daily Choices
Benefit of Accepting Christ: Ultimate Inheritance, but not yet fully realized: eternal life, share in God's Kingdom	Benefit of Daily Following Christ: enjoy some of the fruit, get a taste of what is to come: peace, contentment, joy
Conditions: Believe in Jesus as God and the only way to heaven. John 3:36 Confess your sins, leave them behind. Follow Him. Rom 10:9-14, 1John 1:9	Conditions: Do things the way Jesus tells you to do them. John 8:12, Mat 16:24 Help others find Jesus and grow closer to Him (be outwardfocused). Mat 28:19-20
Consequence of not meeting conditions: eternal death and separation from God. John 14:6	Consequence of not meeting conditions: no peace, no current blessings. John 8:34

- Have you chosen Christ as your Lord and Savior? Are you looking forward to the consequences of your choice?
- If you are a Christ-follower, do you choose to listen to Him and do what He says? How do you keep Him as your top priority?
