Avoid the Downward Spiral

If you make the wrong decisions, seek the wrong counsel, and have the wrong attitude, you will be prone to a downward spiral moving away from God.

Avoid the Downward Spiral by Living Like Jesus

- 1. SERVE OTHERS, *Mat* 20:26-28. This is unlike our culture, but is the model Jesus gave us to follow.
 - · Are you willing to serve others regardless of what's in it for you?
 - Do you look around for opportunities to serve others?
- 2. SEEK GODLY COUNSEL, **Pro 11:14**, **Pro 20:18**. Jesus prayed to His Father and sought to do His will.
 - · Do you pray, asking God what He wants?
 - Do you listen to what He says?
 - Do you do what He says?
- 3. MODEL HUMILITY, *Php 2:3-4*. Jesus was the ultimate model of humility.
 - Do you consider the needs of others?
 - Do you speak the truth in love, Eph 4:29?
 - Do you admit your mistakes and make amends?

Sad Example of What NOT to Do

- King Rehoboam made wrong decisions, 1Kgs 12:1-7. He failed to lead for God as a servant leader.
- King Rehoboam sought the wrong counsel, 1Kgs 12:8-11.
 He listened to those who told him what he wanted to hear, instead of seeking God's will.
- King Rehoboam had the wrong attitude, 1Kgs 12:12-15.
 He was not humble.

Avoid being like King Rehoboam. Don't get trapped in a downward spiral.
