Share Your Faith Story

Jesus wants you to fish, to share Him with those around you, *Mark 1:17*, *Mark 5:19*. One way to do that is to share your own faith story. Are you prepared to do that? Organize your thoughts into four parts using the example Paul gave us.

My Faith Story

- 1. Your Life BEFORE Jesus, Acts 22:1-5:
- What was your life like as a child?
- What religious influences were there in your early life?
- What were your abilities, personality, and attitude?
- What do you regret about yourself?
- 2. How Jesus SAVED You, Acts 22:6-11:
- What did God use to get your attention? (a trial, a crisis, a loss, a friendship, a chance encounter)
- How did you hear about Jesus? (parent, other relative, friend, neighbor, preacher, teacher)
- How did you give your life to Jesus? (be specific)
- 3. How Jesus CHANGED You, Acts 22:12-16:
- How did your relationships with people change? (found peace with former enemies, experienced rejection from friends or family)
- How did your relationship with God change? (began to listen for His guidance, began to read His Word regularly, began to watch for how He was working in your life and in the lives of others)
- How did your thoughts and behaviors change? (how you viewed the world, how you viewed others, what you began to do to please God)
- 4. What Jesus is Doing TODAY, Acts 22:17-21:
- Where are you currently reading in the Bible and what is God teaching you?
- What are some of your current topics for prayer?
- In what areas of your life is God challenging you?
- Who is God using you to impact spiritually for Him?
- What are you thankful for today?
