Read **Eph 1:17-19**.

Pray, asking Jesus to:

- give us spiritual insight and fill us with His light.

- help people serve their church by filling volunteer roles.
- give each of us a deep conviction to be connected to the body of Christ, His church.

Look to Jesus as your Leader

Read **Eph 1:19-23**.

Pray, asking Jesus to help you:

- know the greatness of His power toward believers.
- acknowledge Him as having all power and authority over you.
- remember to ask Him what He wants, listen to Him, and do as He asks.
- trust Him to produce the results in you He wants and remember to praise Him for it.
- stay connected to Him and His church.
